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Hello! Have you ever wondered how your support of PTSA actually helps our RMS students, faculty and staff? Our board takes each and every dollar of support and strives to use it as wisely as possible to benefit our school.

Your support of PTSA – through fundraising/donating, membership, and volunteering – directly helps RMS to become an even greater school.

Our recent fundraiser efforts raised almost \$10,000 to be invested back into the school and its programming. The majority of that money has been earmarked for Teacher Requests, and it is awarded through a mini-grant program in which the teachers apply for funding for specific projects and activities.

This year's teacher request effort again includes support that will benefit every student in the school:

- ◆ subscribing to academic magazines for foreign language and English/Language arts classes
- ◆ underwriting field trips to help pay for students unable to pay for themselves
- ◆ purchasing safety equipment for ECC
- ◆ paying for math competition fees and transportation so that all of our Mathletes may participate
- ◆ acquiring Geiger Counters for science classes
- ◆ purchasing quality headphones for social studies classes
- ◆ providing supplies for the school health clinic
- ◆ paying for an assembly during Black History Month
- ◆ underwriting the cost of academic programming provided by SECME and Titan's extracurricular clubs

In recent years, Teacher Requests have also been used to refurbish the library with all new tables and chairs, provide safety fencing around our wetland, supplement classroom libraries with new books, and support the construction of the playground.

Throughout the year, funds raised by PTSA via donations and memberships are used for a wide variety of other school support. PTSA pays for the landscaping around the school that helps beautify our campus, we provide teacher appreciation hospitality events, we supply snacks for the students during major testing weeks (TNReady), and we fund the end of year celebration at the Oak Ridge pool.

As you can see, it takes all of us to make RMS such a wonderful learning environment for all of our students.

Your support, through donations, memberships, fundraiser purchases, and volunteer hours help us to help RMS. We welcome any contributions you can make during the year and look forward to working with you. Thank you for all your support!

RMS SKI CLUB—2018 at Ober Gatlinburg



We will take four trips to the mountain this Winter on Wednesdays. Our dates have tentatively been scheduled January 10, 17, 24 and 31.

Each week students will participate in lessons led by the instructors of the Gatlinburg Snow Sports Center, and they will also have plenty of free time to practice their skills. We expect our students to exhibit excellent behavior and represent our school well. We will have several RMS staff members with the club each week. However, due to nature of this activity, students must be able to function with a high degree of independence at the resort in order to check out/return equipment, be on time for the required lesson, and meet the group for departure. Our schedule is very tight to make the Ober tram, so students must be efficient and prompt! We

leave at 1:00 on Wednesdays and we return to RMS around 9:00.

Ski Club is primarily open to 7th and 8th grade students; however, we do open membership to 6th graders if we have room on the bus. Ski Club members are expected to be in good standing for academics, behavior, and attendance. Plan ahead now if you think your student might be interested in participating in Ski Club. Fees are not finalized, but based on last year's costs we expect the cost to be approximately \$230 (includes lesson, lift ticket, bus transportation, equipment rental, and club shirt). Several of our skiers received Ski Club memberships as part of their Christmas gifts. This may be a good option for your family. All participants must wear appropriate clothes and they MUST have good gloves. Snowboarders are required to wear wrist guards. ALL STUDENTS MUST WEAR A HELMET!!! Helmets will be part of the rental package. We are looking forward to a great ski season. **THINK SNOW!!!**

TREMONT INSTITUTE Twelve 6th/7th graders who were recommended by their teachers, attended the Tremont Institute from Oct 1-3. The students hiked to a waterfall, searched for salamanders, participated in a cooperation course, a night hike, and identified native trees. During a program by the Appalachian Bear Rescue Group, students role-played rescuing and caring for abandoned bears. Students also viewed live birds of prey and learned about their characteristics during a raptor bird program by the Smoky Mountain Raptor Center. It was a wonderful trip - not only did RMS students learn a lot, but they represented our school very well!



WAYS YOU CAN HELP!

There are so many ways parents and students can help make our daily lives at RMS as productive, healthy and enjoyable as possible. Here are a few ways you can help:

FIELD TRIPS AT RMS

Please support field trips by sending in requested payments! Our students are fortunate to have field trips. Not every school offers the opportunity to go to a play or musical performance or to tour a museum related to something the students have studied. Unfortunately, with school funding becoming ever tighter, field trips are not something that can be paid for by the RMS budget. It is necessary for parents to pay the costs of the field trips to the extent that they are able.

Whenever a teacher plans a field trip, he or she sends home a permission slip that includes a polite request for payment. The school cannot require payment from anyone, and no child will be denied the opportunity to participate, regardless of whether he or she pays. Parents won't receive repeated reminders to send in payment for field trips. But if payment isn't received, there will be a shortfall and the field trip may need to be canceled or the money will be borrowed from another field trip, and that next event will not happen.

PTSA has pledged to use some of the fundraising moneys raised this year to underwrite field trips to help cover the cost for people who truly cannot pay. But it is imperative for everyone who can pay something to do so. When the majority of people do not send in money, as is often the case at RMS, field trips become unsustainable. If we wish for these opportunities to be made available to our kids, we need to support them by sending in money when asked to the extent that each of us is able.

CLINIC SUPPLY DONATIONS NEEDED

RMS Health Clinic:

- 1) Boxes of tissues
- 2) 3 oz paper bathroom cups (our RMS Clinic uses up to 200 cups each month!)
- 3) Cough drops—honey lemon preferred and a small amount of sugar free (our RMS clinic uses 1-2 bags a month!)
- 4) Quart size Gatorade or Powerade, preferably lemon lime or “frost” and not the red, blue or purple
- 5) Granola bars or Nutrigrain-type bars-nice to have a variety (gluten free, nut free are much appreciated too)
- 6) Fruit snacks—Vitamin C ; no high fructose corn syrup if possible
- 7) Ziplock freezer bag for ice (sandwich and quart size)


